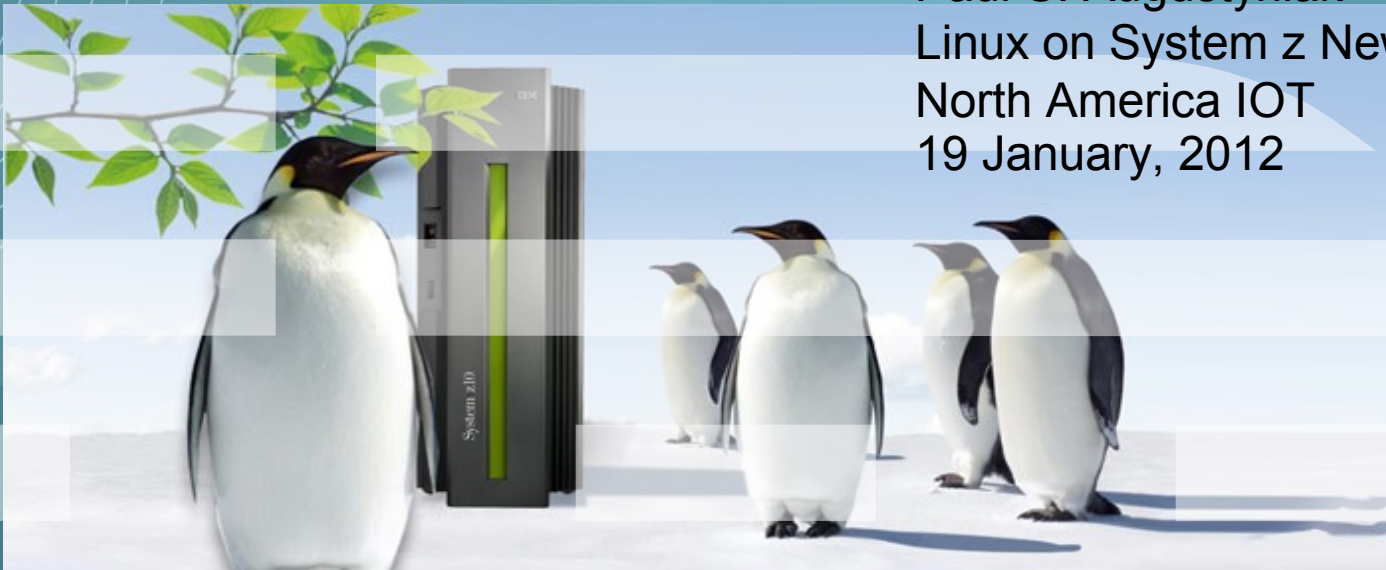

Execution of x86 applications takes place transparently and under control of Linux on System z, and management of processes, userids, file systems, packages, and other resources is unified and centered on Linux on System z.
