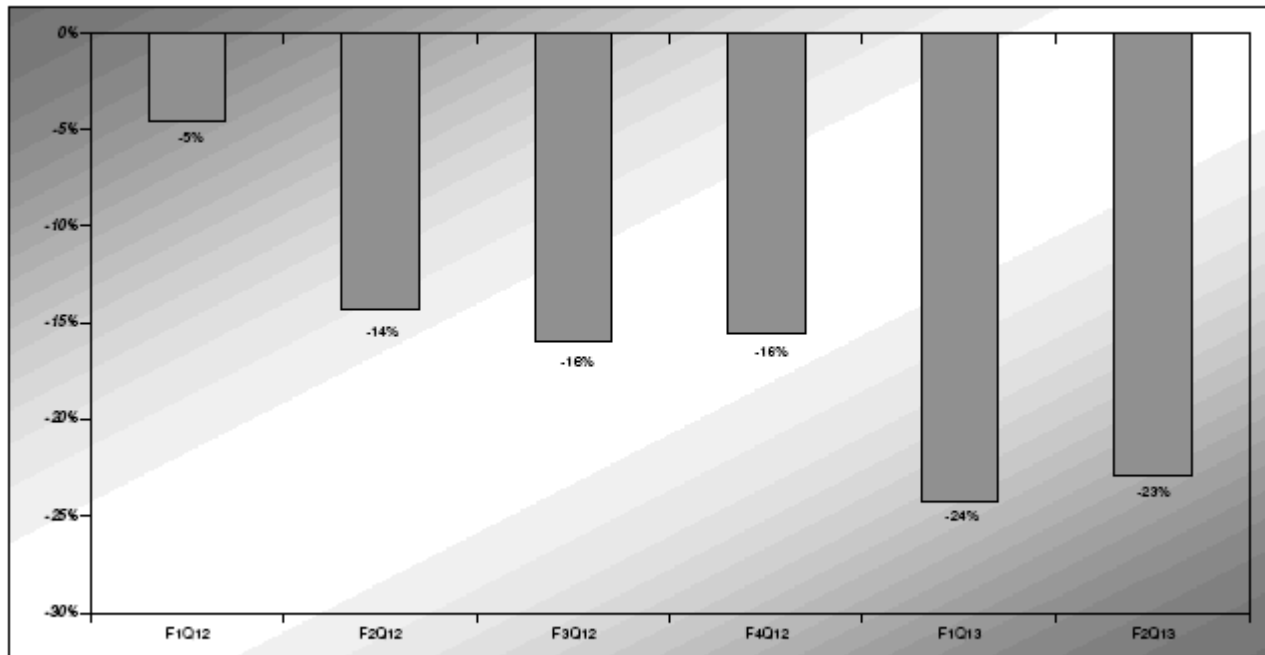

# News Youse Can Use.... the zEnterprise EC12 rocked the house!!

- System z performance in Q4 and in 2012 was simply outstanding
- System z grew 56% year over year
- 66% MIPS shipment growth Y/Y – the best in history
- Speciality engines comprised half the MIPS growth in Q4
- System z carried STG and delivered strong revenue to the IBM Corporation

## ORCL

We maintain our Market Perform rating on Oracle after the company reported better than expected F2Q non-GAAP EPS of \$0.64 (consensus \$0.61) and provided guidance that was in line for EPS, but a little light on revenue causing the stock to trade up 1% in the aftermarket. The company generally executed well in the quarter with new license and cloud subscription revenue growth of 17% versus the consensus of 9%, although hardware missed guidance for the second quarter in a row. The big takeaway from the call is that Oracle seems to be experiencing a strong, year-end budget flush, which has positive implications for other enterprise software vendors. In particular, we would highlight Informatica (INFA, Market Outperform, \$38PT), SAP (SAP, Market Perform) and Teradata (TDC, Market Outperform, \$87PT - covered by McDowell) as vendors who might be seeing similar trends. We are increasing our FY13 non-GAAP EPS estimate from \$2.63 to \$2.68 (consensus \$2.65), and are maintaining our FY14 EPS estimate of \$2.88 (consensus \$2.91). Oracle trades at a CY13 P/E of 12x, in line with the peer group median.

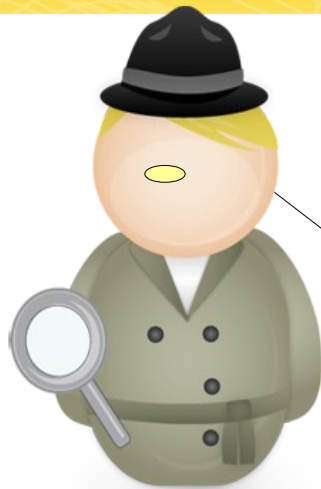

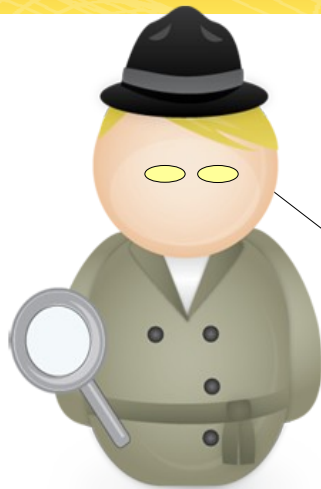

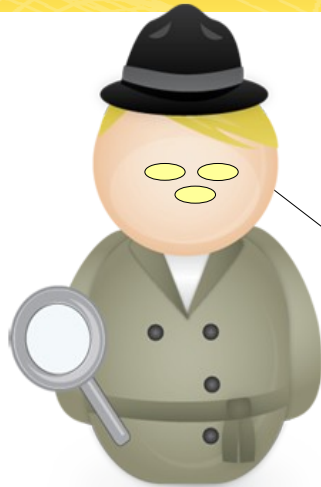
